

Cookies Policy

1. Cookies is a term referring to a certain amount of data stored by our website to your computer or any eligible device (mobile device, tablet, etc.) and necessary for a proper functioning of the website. In each subsequent visit to our website, the browser returns the saved data to the server hosting our website. Cookies are commonly used to distinguish individual users, and user preferences are saved in them. Third-party websites are sometimes retrieved together with the loading of our website. Third parties usually help us monitor the traffic and visits to our website. In these cases, the data stored in cookies are sent by your browser to the servers hosting the third-party websites.
2. Our website does not use any first-party cookies that would require your consent.
3. Our website uses third-party services that store their cookies to monitor the traffic and visits to our website. We have no control over their contents. However, your consent is required for their use. You can obtain more information about these cookies on the links listed for each of them:
